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Dr. Fayaz Shawl has been a pioneer in virtually every area of interventional cardiology since he performed the first angioplasty at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington DC in 1981. Dr Shawl, having performed more than 19,000 angioplasty procedures, is considered to have performed more such procedures, as a single operator, than any other interventionalist in the world. He is well known for his famous “Shawl Technique” (Percutaneous Approach to Cardiopulmonary Bypass Support in High Risk Angioplasty and Cardiac Arrest). Currently in pursuit of stroke prevention, Dr. Shawl has pioneered the technique of Carotid Artery Stenting.
