- Dr. Parikh has done her Post Doctoral Fellowship in the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology from the prestigious Yale University School of Medicine, New Haven, USA after completing MD (Obs & Gynae) and Diploma in Family Planning from Bombay.

- Dr. Parikh has trained at the Yale University as a post doctoral researcher in Reproductive Medicine for 4 years.

- Dr. Parikh was the first to help deliver South East Asia's first micromanipulation baby in 1994 and the first laser-hatching pregnancy in 1999. She has many such medical firsts to her credit like Cumulus Aided Transfer (CAT) that increases pregnancy rates with IVF.
- On completing the milestone of 1000 deliveries to infertile couples in 1999, India's internationally acclaimed painter M.F. Hussain created an exclusive painting in her honour.
- She is the founder director of Reliance Life Sciences, India, who are listed by NIH as the third best institute for stem cells.
