44-YEAR-OLD ENGINEER RECOVERED FROM A LIFE THREATENING SEVERE ACUTE PANCREATITIS

Santosh a 44-year-old Indian working as an engineer in UAE had been suffering from severe abdominal pain for over six weeks. He was treated for severe acute pancreatitis by Specialist Gastroenologist, Dr. Shareej at Zulekha Hospital, Dubai.

A few days later he experienced pain again with fever, nausea and vomiting. Investigations were carried out and a CT scan revealed an infected walled-off necrosis (dead tissue due to lack of blood supply) which resulted from the previous acute pancreatitis, along with a left-sided pleural effusion (abnormal collection of fluid between the thin layers of tissue lining the lung and the wall of the chest cavity). The cyst measured 14.6x10.2x8.6cm. He also had symptoms that indicated sepsis which could lead to lifethreatening complications, if unattended.

Dr. Fathelrahman Mohammed, Consultant General Surgery at the hospital, recommended a minimal invasive drainage procedure under ultrasound guidance, assisted by Dr. Anurag Ayachit, Specialist Radiologist. His infection continued to progress and this emergency now required a multidisciplinary team of clinicians including general surgeons, gastroenterologist, radiologist, intensivists, anaesthetists, a clinical dietitian and nursing staff to help save him.

Without wasting any time, a set of minimal invasive surgeries was carried out by Dr. Fathelrahman along with Dr. Saajan Ignatius Pius, Specialist General Surgeon and Dr. Ajay Patekar, Consultant Anaesthesiologist using advanced medical techniques. Santosh had to undergo multiple procedures, including a laparoscopic cystogastrostomy, laparoscopic pancreatic necrosectomy, laparoscopic drainage of collection (abscesses) and intercostal tube insertion for pleural effusion

These procedures facilitated the drainage of fluid collection directly into the stomach to prevent fistula formation. The necrotic dead tissue was successfully removed, and the encysted pus collection drained, relieving the lung collapse.

Dr. Fathelrahman said, "The acute pancreatitis may have happened due to presence of high lipids in the blood. People should be watchful as acute pancreatitis can happen as a result of high lipids. Avoiding alcohol, fatty meals and checking for gallstones can be helpful. In situations such as these, where the individual develops severe attacks with complication, they must choose the right hospital with multidisciplinary care for treatment."

Acknowledging the life-saving care at the hospital Santosh said, "Their expertise and careful efforts in the intensive care unit led to the successful removal of the necrotic dead tissue and my life has been saved. I am extremely thankful to all the doctors and nursing staff at the hospital."

Santosh recovered within nine days and was discharged with guidance on managing his health more effectively.



54-YEAR-OLD WITH REPEATED CARDIAC ARRESTS SAVED WITH URGENT MEDICAL INTERVENTION

A 54-year-old resident, Adithyan, was rushed to Zulekha Hospital with heart attack and cardiac arrest. He was immediately attended to and successfully treated by Specialist Interventional Cardiologist, Dr. Jayachandran Thejus at the hospital's Cath Lab along with our experienced nursing teams. When the patient was brought to the hospital, he was immediately given highly-effective cardiopulmonary resuscitation with chest compressions and shocks by the emergency room doctors and nurses. The patient continued to be in cardiac arrest and was urgently transferred to the catheterization laboratory with ongoing resuscitative efforts.

Coronary angiography was done and it revealed total block of a main blood vessel supplying the heart. The block was removed by coronary angioplasty with stenting. The patient was stabilized and there was no further recurrence of the cardiac arrest.

This case emphasizes the importance of seeking immediate medical attention in the event of a heart attack. Dr. Jayachandran commented: "Approximately 1/3rd to 1/4th of heart attack patients develop cardiac arrests." When experiencing chest discomfort that indicates a heart attack, it is critical to seek medical attention and reach the nearest hospital without delay. This instance demonstrates that even in the case of cardiac arrest, with timely intervention and treatment, patients can usually be saved."

Adithyan was discharged in stable condition and has since returned to his daily routine on the job and his personal life. He has been advised to take care with regular medication, exercises and a healthy diet.

Doctors highlight that heart diseases are increasing in younger adults. Lack of exercise, unhealthy food, stress and under treatment of predisposing conditions like diabetes, high blood pressure or high cholesterol are the leading causes. Maintaining a disciplined schedule for sleep and food intake is essential and must not be compromised by any individual.



MEDICAL MIRACLE SAVES UNCONSCIOUS EXPAT

An acute stroke was resuscitated based solely on clinical diagnosis without any supportive imaging evidence. Real-time decisionmaking is key to saving lives in Neurology treatments. Sajid Mulla, a young Dubai resident who arrived at the emergency room in

an unconscious state after experiencing dizziness at home, was miraculously resuscitated within 30 minutes of his arrival by Dr. Shyam Babu Chandran, Consultant Neurologist and Movement Disorder Specialist at Zulekha Hospital, Dubai. The doctor made a critical decision to proceed urgently with thrombolysis, relying on subtle clinical findings despite no evidence from all investigations, including CT and MRI Brain, after obtaining consent from the family.

Dr. Shyam commented, "Though Thrombolysis is a regular procedure, this is a rare case in many years where a patient came to us in an unconscious state and was treated based on clinical suspicion alone in this emergency. As a result, he was thrombolysed with IV rt-PA. Despite no supportive evidence. Sajid was brought back to life, and a clinical follow-up showed minimal deficits. The CT Brain revealed changes on the right side of the brain, which further validated the medical decision taken by the clinical team."

Doctors advise individuals always to rush to the emergency room in case of any symptoms and undergo a medical examination to avoid fatal consequences. Sajid would have been left with permanent damage to the brain if this decision hadn't been taken promptly, as there was no investigation supporting it at that crucial time. Strokes can recur, and it is essential to exercise and monitor diabetes, lipids, and high blood pressure.

Sajid recovered well and underwent a few weeks of physiotherapy to regain muscle strength in his left arm. Expressing gratitude to the doctor, he said, "I have no previous diseases and always considered myself fit and fine. When this happened, we panicked and rushed to the hospital. I was lucky to be revived by an experienced medical team who knew what had to be done."

The successful management of this rare medical case is a testament to the medical expertise of the clinical team, who made a critical decision to save a life. Zulekha Hospital is known for accepting and successfully treating high-risk cases from many other healthcare facilities in the UAE. Thanks to the multidisciplinary teams and advanced infrastructure at the hospital, they provide quality critical care for their patrons.

A 22-year old Ugandan resident of UAE had an emergency delivery at Zulekha Hospital. Dubai due to severe eclampsia (hypertension in pregnancy) with blood pressure of 240/110 mmHg. Her baby boy, born prematurely at 26 weeks had a miraculous survival against all odds, and returned home after two months of stay at the NICU unit of the hospital. He weighed 550 gm at birth, which was very small for gestational age. He now weighs 2.1 kg and this has been possible with round-the-clock vigilance and care of the NICU team. Overwhelmed with joy the mother said, "I never thought I would ever enjoy this beautiful moment. My joy at holding my own little baby boy in my arms is indescribable."

SUCCESSFUL TONGUE RECONSTRUCTION SURGERY BY **TEAM OF DOCTORS AT ZULEKHA HOSPITAL**

Mr. Zaid Hussain was experiencing a lot of pain in the left side of the tongue while chewing food and visited Zulekha Hospital to consult Dr. Keerthi Ravi, Consultant Surgical Oncologist. It had been 4 months since the pain began, and Mr. Zaid was advised to take a biopsy and an MRI. The biopsy report revealed it was cancer.

Dr. Keerthi explained to Zaid the steps of treatment and surgery and how the reconstruction of the radial femoral flap was being done. The procedure was a left Hemiglossectomy, followed by neck dissection. This reconstruction surgery was done by Dr. Surendra Kumar Chawla, Consultant Plastic Surgery. The reconstruction of the tongue was done with tissues from the arm, to resume the normal function of the tongue. Mr. Zaid stated that he was very nervous about the surgery, but both doctors made him comfortable and painless with minimal discomfort. //

HIPeC SURGERY - A SAVIOUR FOR OVARIAN CANCERS!

A 47-year-old lady presented with complaints of early satiety and weight loss. The most common causes of early satiety include gastroesophageal reflux disease, commonly known as GERD and peptic ulcers. In some cases, a more serious problem, such as stomach cancer, could also be a factor. Upon evaluation by Dr. Krunal Khobragade, Onco-Surgeon at Alexis Hospital, it was found that she had a lump in her lower abdomen, and her CT scan revealed bilateral ovarian masses with deposits in the peritoneum and omentum (the peritoneum is the serous membrane lining the cavity of the abdomen and covering the abdominal organs, while the omentum plays a key role in immune regulation and tissue regeneration).

Her tumour markers were also elevated, and her staging laparoscopy indicated ovarian cancer spread to the peritoneum and omentum, along with some free fluid in the pelvis. Her biopsy confirmed ovarian cancer. All the investigations suggested stage III ovarian cancer. The treating doctors organised an internal tumour board meeting to discuss and plan the best course of action. They decided to proceed with neoadjuvant chemotherapy. She then received four cycles of neoadjuvant chemotherapy under the supervision of Dr. Mukesh Bang, Medical Oncologist.

She was treated with the most technically demanding and advanced treatment: cytoreductive surgery with heated intraperitoneal chemotherapy. This surgery has the best outcomes for patients with ovarian cancer. Multiple procedures were performed in the initial stage to remove the tumours spread in her abdominal area. This was followed by a HIPeC procedure in which a few tubes were inserted into the peritoneal cavity, and heated chemotherapy was administered in the abdomen for one and a half hours. During this procedure, the patient's kidney and liver functions were carefully monitored. The lady tolerated the procedure very well, and post-operation, she did not require any further support. Even after such complex surgery, she recovered gradually in the ward itself with the dedicated support of the welltrained nursing staff.

She started a planned diet three days after her procedure and was discharged on the tenth day in stable condition. She will be following up as planned.



WATERMELON-SIZED RARE FIBROID OF 5 KG SUCCESSFULLY REMOVED AT ALEXIS HOSPITAL

A 42-year-old woman walked into Alexis Hospital, appearing to be pregnant, with complaints of significant discomfort and pressure in the lower abdominal area. Upon examination by Dr. Rajni Gupta, Obstetrician and Gynaecologist at Alexis Hospital, a large abdominal mass was discovered, almost the size of a midsized watermelon, resembling a full-term pregnancy. An MRI scan revealed a rare and highly vascular massive broad ligament fibroid.

A broad ligament fibroid is a benign smooth muscle tumour that originates from the hormone-sensitive smooth muscle of the broad ligament, or secondarily from the uterine smooth muscle. This layer of tissue connects the sides of the uterus to the walls and floor of the pelvis, covering the uterus, ovaries and fallopian tubes, while also connecting nerves and blood vessels to these organs.

Dr. Rajni advised her to undergo surgery, which initially scared her. The doctor provided counselling and with meticulous planning and thorough preparation, the operation was performed. A massive five-kilogram fibroid measuring 25 x 20 cm was successfully removed. Due to its vascularity and the high-risk of massive bleeding and injury to nearby structures, the fibroid's adherence and technical difficulty made its removal challenging. The patient experienced a smooth recovery and was discharged on the third day after the surgery.

Dr. Rajni Gupta states, "Although uterine fibroids are common tumours of the uterus, these broad ligament fibroids of such massive size constitute less than 1% of overall cases and are very rarely found."

During her discharge, the patient shared, "I was surprised to learn that my case was rare and yet was treated easily at Alexis. I will forever be thankful to Dr. Rajni Gupta for her continued support and the quality care provided by the multidisciplinary team. The doctor's knowledge of the latest methods of treatment at this prestigious Alexis Hospital has truly saved me."

BONE TUMOUR ABLATION SURGERY SUCCESSFULLY PERFORMED FOR THE FIRST TIME IN INDIA AT ALEXIS HOSPITAL

A 46-year-old man consulted the Interventional Radiologist at Alexis Hospital due to a history of left knee pain for the past three months. He was evaluated by Dr. Mohammad Zuber, Interventional Radiologist at Alexis Hospital, who recommended an MRI scan. The knee scan reports revealed the presence of a benign tumour in the knee bone. Subsequently, he underwent a CT-guided biopsy for further histopathological evaluation, which confirmed the presence of a benign bone tumour–a giant cell tumour of the knee bone. Based on these findings, Dr. Zuber recommended surgery. However, the patient was apprehensive about an extended hospital stay and post-surgery pain. After receiving education and counselling from Dr. Zuber about minimally invasive image-guided procedures (MIIPs), the patient readily agreed with confidence.

A giant cell tumour, also known as osteoclastoma, is a benign bone tumour that exhibits local aggressiveness. It is commonly observed in adults aged 20 to 30 years. The standard treatment typically involves surgical resection or curettage, often accompanied by local adjuvants such as phenol or bone cement.

Dr. Zuber devised a plan for Percutaneous Image-Guided Microwave Ablation of the bone turnour, combined with Zoledronic acid-infused polymethylmethacrylate (PMMA) cementoplasty. This procedure is a recent advancement in interventional radiology, characterized by its minimally invasive nature, reduced pain, shorter hospital stays and decreased complication rates. Notably, there are no post-surgery incisions or scars and the outcomes closely resemble those of traditional surgery. The procedure was conducted under local anaesthesia. Microwave ablation employs thermal energy to treat the turnour, with minimal chances of recurrence. Zoledronic acid-infused PMMA cement facilitates bone formation within the turnour cavity. The entire procedure took less than 40 minutes, and the patient was able to walk shortly after the procedure. He was discharged the following day and could walk without pain.

Subsequent follow-up care was overseen by Senior Consultant Medical Oncologist, Dr. Amol Dongre in conjunction with a team of Radiologists, including Dr. Niraj Kanchankar, Dr. Shahab Sharif, Dr. Meghna Ganvir, and Dr. Nikhil Landge.

Dr. Zuber remarked, "The patient has been treated with the most technically demanding and advanced technique. Additionally, this minimally invasive procedure, a first in India, contributes to rapid recovery and shorter hospital stays. The results of this procedure are similar to those of traditional surgery."



POST-DELIVERY COMPLICATIONS SUCCESSFULLY TREATED AT ALEXIS HOSPITAL

In an emergency, a 29-year-old female patient arrived at Alexis Hospital with septic shock and disseminated intravascular coagulopathy, a rare and serious condition that disrupts blood flow and can lead to uncontrollable bleeding. She had undergone a caesarean delivery at another private hospital four days before being admitted to Alexis Hospital. On admission, she presented with a high-grade fever, low blood pressure (shock), respiratory distress and experienced one convulsion just prior to arriving at Alexis Hospital. Dr. Nitin Wadaskar, a Consultant Physician, admitted her to the ICU, where she was immediately intubated and put on a life support system. A team of doctors, including Dr. Sanjay Kriplani, Intensivist and Dr. Sakshi Bansal, Gynaecologist closely monitored her case. A CT scan of her abdomen revealed gross Hemoperitoneum, a condition where blood accumulates in the peritoneal cavity. She was already on life-supporting medications and devices, and her condition necessitated multiple blood products to control her internal bleeding and maintain her blood pressure. Her risks were further escalated due to acute kidney shutdown, for which she received continuous renal support from Dr. Nishant Deshpande, Nephrologist & Renal Transplant Physician and Dr. Vishal Ramteke, Nephrologist at Alexis Hospital.

After three days of intense treatment and critical care efforts, when her blood pressure stabilised, Dr. Mohammad Zuber, Interventional Radiologist decided to perform CT-guided embolisation of the bleeding vessels to halt her bleeding. Following this, Dr. Mohammad Yunus, General and Laparoscopic Surgeon and Dr. Sakshi Bansal, Gynaecologist removed 325 grams of clots through laparotomy, along with 2.3 litters of blood from her abdomen. Post-laparotomy, her blood pressure, heart rate, and respiration became stable, and her kidney function began to improve. She was discharged in remarkable condition after 23 days of hospitalization.

Dr. Nitin Wadaskar, Consultant Physician stated that the patient was in a critical stage with septic shock, coagulation abnormalities and was on ventilator support. Timely and coordinated management, along with a collaborative team effort, played a crucial role in the patient's survival. The support and belief of the patient's relatives were also contributing factors to her recovery.

Dr. Sakshi Bansal, Gynaecologist shared, "Though she was in shock and her case was among the most challenging to handle, we at Alexis Hospital were able to save her due to our multidisciplinary approach and support from our colleagues. As the saying goes, if a mother is saved, the entire family is saved. She was a mother of two children, and her case was a near-miss maternal mortality."

Throughout her treatment, the patient received a total of 34 units of blood products, including 8 cryoprecipitates, 8 fresh frozen plasma units, 13 packed red blood cells, 3 single donor platelets and 2 random donor platelets.
